Student Ministry

Guys Sunday School Teacher

Alternative host home for MS and HS guy's small group on Sunday evening.

We have around 10

students and adults that meet. The current host home already has a small group meeting there, so it is not an ideal scenario. Small groups meet on Sundays at 5pm-7pm.
